

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF VARIOUS ROADS, WEYMOUTH AND TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT MEASURES FOR DORSET SEAFOOD FESTIVAL (2019)

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to prohibit the use of the roads and parts of road described below, at the times indicated, by cyclists, horse riders and all mechanically propelled vehicles, except those taking part in the event and emergency vehicles -

### Road closures

**[A] Saturday 13 July, between 06.00hrs and 20.00hrs AND Sunday 14 July, between 08.00hrs and 20.00hrs**

- **Custom House Quay** between South Parade and Town Bridge
- **St Thomas Street and Town Bridge** between St Edmund Street and North Quay/Trinity Road
- **North Quay** between the access road to the former council offices and Trinity Road/Town Bridge
- **Trinity Road**
- **Cove Row**

**[B\*] Saturday 13 July and Sunday 14 July, between 11.00hrs and 20.00hrs, daily**

- **The Esplanade** between King Statue and Pavilion car park, in this direction only\*\*
- **Lower St Alban Street and St. Thomas Street** between St Nicholas Street and St. Edmund Street

\* CSAS accredited marshals will operate at closure points **[B\*]** to grant restricted access only as appropriate, including to licenced Taxis, Private Hire vehicles and holders of a disabled blue-badge.

\*\* Access out of the Pavilion car park towards the King Statue will not be affected by temporary regulations at any time.

**[C] between 06.00hrs, Saturday 13 July and 20.00hrs, Sunday 14 July**

- **Custom House Quay** between The Esplanade and South Parade

**As a result of [A], [B\*] and [C] above, the following measures will take effect:**

1. **To maintain access to and from Nothe Parade**, the No Entry Order at junction of Spring Road and Horsford Street will be **revoked between 06.00hrs and 20.00hrs, Saturday 13 July AND between 08.00hrs and 20.00hrs Sunday 14 July**
2. **Alternative route for vehicular traffic** will be via Rodwell Road, Rodwell Avenue and Spring Road in both directions
3. **To maintain access from The Esplanade to Custom House Quay**, the one-way system in South Parade will be **reversed between 20.00hrs, Saturday 13 July and 08.00hrs, Sunday 14 July**

### Parking restrictions

**[A] between 09.00hrs, Friday 12 July and 20.00hrs, Sunday 14 July**, parking suspended on:

- **Custom House Quay** - first three spaces outside the Harbour Master's office and five spaces outside the Anchor Pub
- **Trinity Road** - three spaces at the eastern end of the bay adjacent to the Sand Jetty

**[B] between 15.00hrs, Friday 12 July and 20.00hrs, Sunday 14 July**, parking suspended on:

- **Custom House Quay** - between South Parade and Maiden Street
- **Trinity Road** (including adjacent to the Sand Jetty)
- **Cove Row**

**[C] between 15.00hrs, Friday 12 July and 20.00hrs, Sunday 14 July**, parking suspended on:

- **Custom House Quay** between the Esplanade and South Parade
- **South Parade**
- **North Quay** between the access road to the former council offices and the Town Bridge

### Permit holders

- **Zone L permit holders** are permitted to park in the **Nothe Car Park**, free of charge, when the above restrictions are in operation for this zone
- **Zone F permit holders** are permitted to park in the **Swannery Car Park**, free of charge, when the above restrictions are in operation for this zone.

## Other traffic management measures

- **North Quay** - the pedestrian crossing nearest the Town Bridge **will be closed** to pedestrians. Stop/go boards will operate on the north side carriageway from the existing crossing site to the end of the motorcycle bay. A temporary crossing will be in operation east of the existing crossing point. Between 20.00hrs Saturday 13 July and 08.00hrs Sunday 14 July
- **Westham Road** - a temporary passenger bus stop will be located outside the Londis convenience store and will operate on **Saturday 13 July, between 06.00hrs and 20.00hrs AND Sunday 14 July, between 08.00hrs and 20.00hrs**. Disabled blue badge holders will **not** be able to park in the designated bus stop during its hours of operation

**:: Any vehicle waiting in contravention of the restrictions imposed by this Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.**

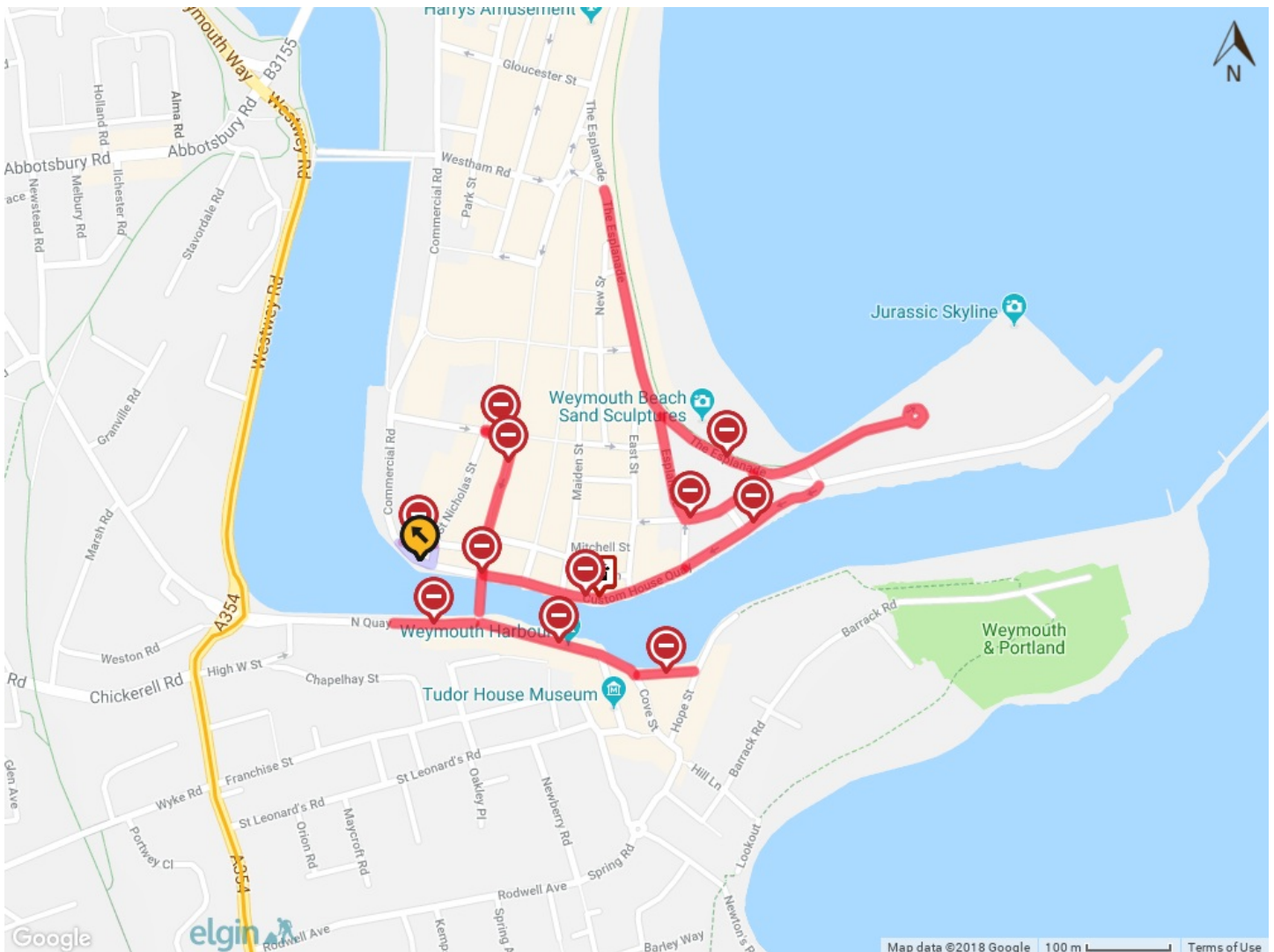
